First Fridays w/ Mr. Sanders/Anti-Bullying Next Friday's virtual community meeting will center on Information about Mental Health Resources at Bill Roberts and Anti-Bullying (October is Nat'l Bullying Prevention Month). Members of our school's Mental Health Team will be presenting in addition to school updates from Mr. Sanders. School Conferences/School Conference Day Each year, we field questions about how we go about our school conferences. Here is some importation information for parents:

- Elementary teachers are asked, in the fall, to meet with all families if possible. This can be over 50 families depending on the grade
- In the spring, Elementary Teachers are required to prioritize students that are at risk of ending the year below grade level. They may have limited time to meet with all other families, as these sessions are more intensive.
- Middle school teachers will provide a method for parents interested in signing up for a conference. Again, they are asked to prioritize students who may end the year below grade level or who may be experiencing other challenges.
- Conferences will likely feel like they have moved too quickly or you would like more info. That is normal and we appreciate you understanding the magnitude of what we are asking teachers to accomplish for all students.

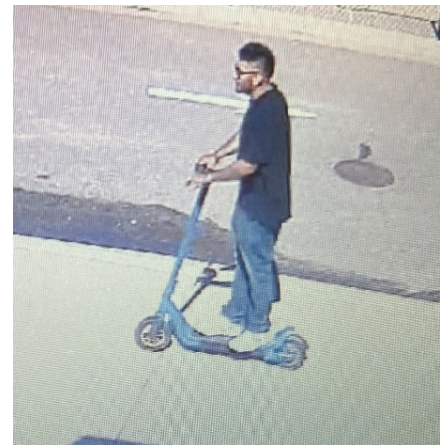
