The program is a cohort model of both monthly classroom-based seminars as well as on-the-job practice. It has been an honor working alongside Mr. Sanders. He has been a great asset to me as my principal mentor through this leadership development journey. **Now, as part of this journey, he gets to step away for my culminating two-week "Acting Principal Experience" that will take place right after the break (January 5 - January 16). Expanding Monday Morning Enrichments! Beginning in mid-late January, we are working to expand our enrichment offerings on Late Start Mondays (sessions will start at 8:50a). Our goal is to prioritize families for whom cost/transportation is prohibitive. After we have determined how many slots would be available, we will either fill the slots with other students or develop a lottery system- depending on the need. Also, we will begin with offerings for


