REMINDER Utilizing the My Ride K-12 App As we work to ensure a safe and efficient school environment. We ask for your assistance in sharing the [My Ride K-12](#) app with parents, students and the DPS community. With this app, parents can receive late bus alerts, view route information and check their student's bus location.

Because these features are offered, scanning on and off the bus is mandatory and students must have a QR code on their phone or printed ID. Physical IDs are being printed for transportation eligible elementary, middle and high school students. Once completed, these IDs will be delivered to your schools for distribution. Aligning with the new cellphone policy, students are permitted to utilize their mobile devices while on the bus to display their digital QR codes. SAFETY Arrival Procedures Arrivals are welcome 10 minutes prior to the start of the school day (unless they are attending Discovery Link, at breakfast or in a club with prior consent provided). *Outdoor supervision does not occur prior to 10 minutes before the start of school.*

- KDG, 1, 2, and 5 grades will meet in front of the school until the bell rings. At that time, they will line up at their class' designated spot and their teacher will

walk them inside to start their day. *KDG “soft start” begins 10 minutes prior to the start of the school day.*

- Grades 3, 4, and 6 meet on the main playground until the bell rings. At that time, they will line up at their class’ designated spot on the playground and their teacher will walk them inside to start their day.
- Grades 7 and 8 meet in the front of the school and will be let into the building prior to elementary grades.

Parking Lot Procedures

- All vehicles must enter the parking lot at the entrance located across from the Police Training Facility on N. Akron Way
- Drivers should adhere to one way directions at all times (see below)
- There is a Kiss-n-Go lane for quick drop-offs. Drivers should not exit vehicle or park their car in the Kiss-n-Go Lane.
- Bus Lane/Fire Lane are no parking areas at all times. Vehicles should not enter this lane unless directed by school personnel.

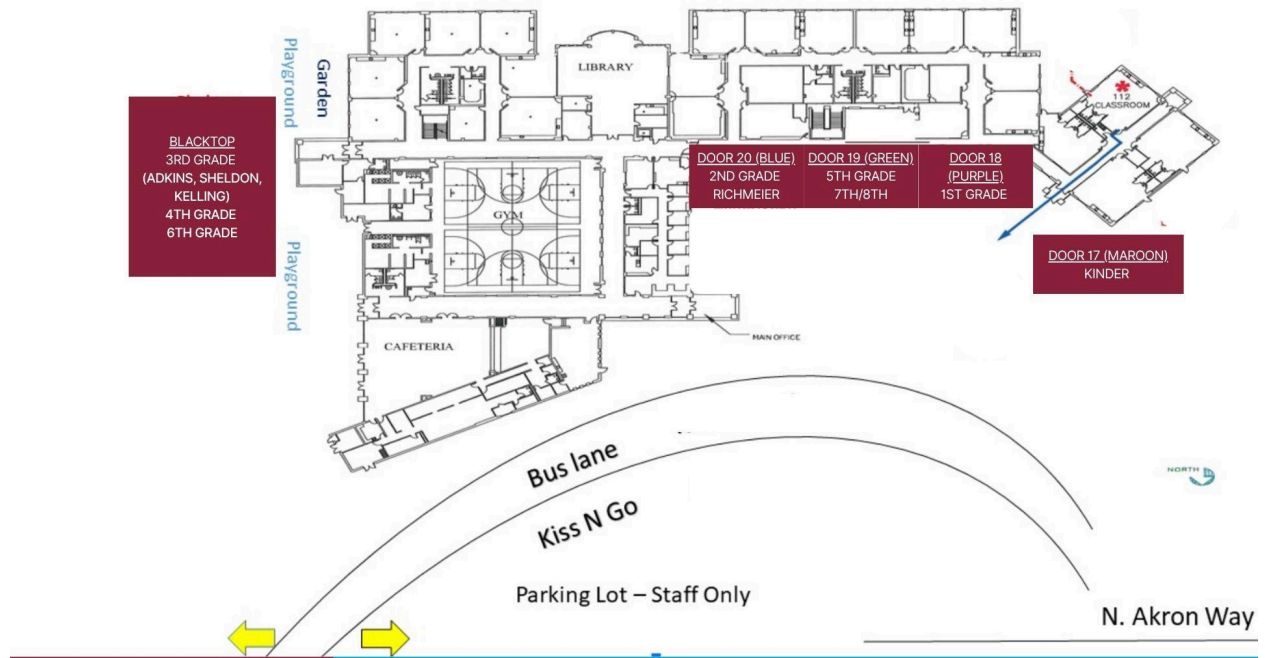
Pedestrian, Bike, Skateboard, Scooter Policies

- Pedestrians have the right of way in all circumstances. Cars and bikes are expected to yield to pedestrians.
- Students and families are asked to dismount bikes, etc. upon entering campus.
- Caregivers and students should cross at designated crosswalks at all times.
- Crosswalks are located on E 22nd and N. Akron Way.
- Additional crosswalks are for students exiting the kiss and go lane.
- Staff crosses students on E 22nd where bus and car traffic exit.
- Student-driven electric modes of transportation are not allowed on campus at any time.

With this app, parents can receive late bus alerts, view route information and check their student's bus location.

Because these features are offered, scanning on and off the bus is mandatory and students must have a QR code on their phone or printed ID. Physical IDs are being printed for transportation eligible elementary, middle and high school students. Once completed, these IDs will be delivered to your schools for distribution. Aligning with the new cellphone policy, students are permitted to utilize their mobile devices while on the bus to display their digital QR codes. SAFETY Arrival Procedures Arrivals are welcome 10 minutes prior to the start of the school day (unless they are attending Discovery Link, at breakfast or in a club with prior consent provided). *Outdoor supervision does not occur prior to 10 minutes before the start of school.*

- KDG, 1, 2, and 5 grades will meet in front of the school until the bell rings. At that time, they will line up at their class' designated spot and their teacher will walk them inside to start their day. *KDG "soft start" begins 10 minutes prior to the start of the school day.*
- Grades 3, 4, and 6 meet on the main playground until the bell rings. At that time, they will line up at their class' designated spot on the playground and their teacher will walk them inside to start their day.
- Grades 7 and 8 meet in the front of the school and will be let into the building prior to elementary grades.

Parking Lot Procedures

- All vehicles must enter the parking lot at the entrance located across from the Police Training Facility on N. Akron Way
- Drivers should adhere to one way directions at all times (see below)
- There is a Kiss-n-Go lane for quick drop-offs. Drivers should not exit vehicle or park their car in the Kiss-n-Go Lane.
- Bus Lane/Fire Lane are no parking areas at all times. Vehicles should not enter this lane unless directed by school personnel.

Pedestrian, Bike, Skateboard, Scooter Policies

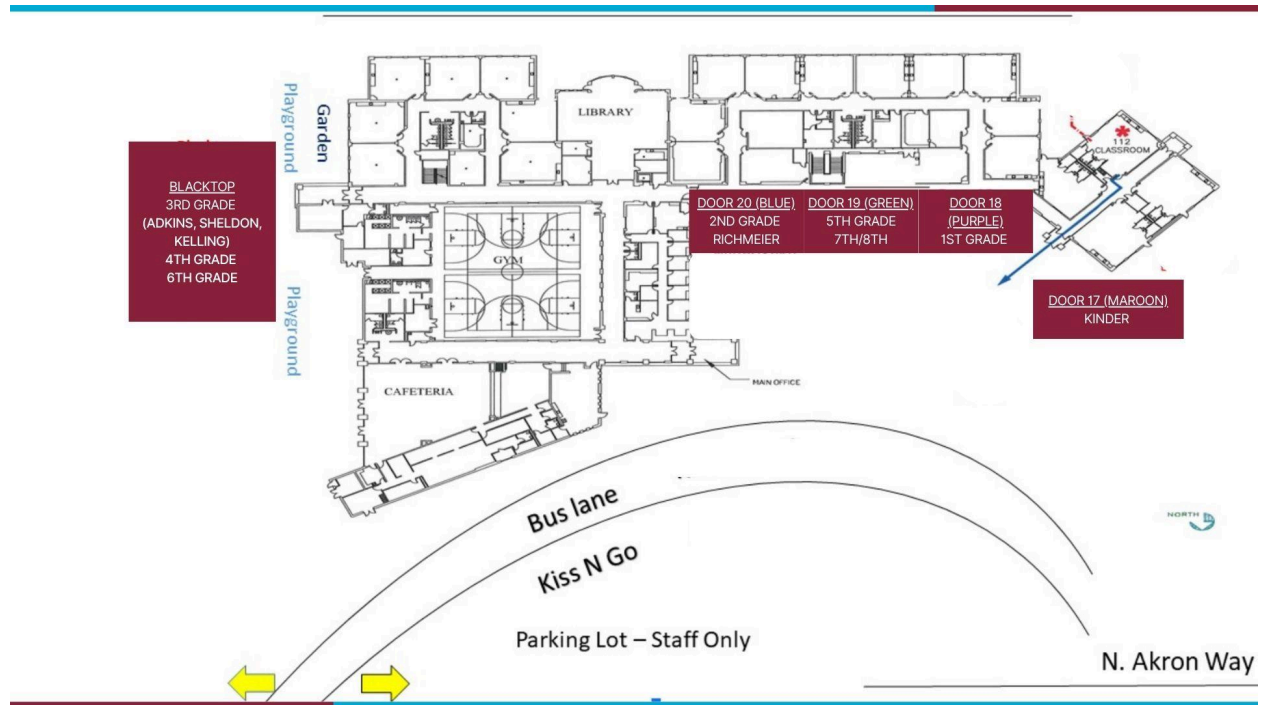
- Pedestrians have the right of way in all circumstances. Cars and bikes are expected to yield to pedestrians.
