Comprehensive Health Department's Youth Advisory Council (YAC) A middle school student at Bill Roberts (Clara Thomas) is participating in the YAC, and will be conducting a Needs Assessment project for the months of September and October. Unless anything changes in the next few days, her needs assessment will begin on September 2nd, and the soft deadline to complete all her activities is October 16, 2024.

This entails Clara conducting interviews and focus groups with various school staff members, along with electronically and anonymously surveying staff, students, and DPS parents. She may even ask to interview you! The purpose is to identify successes and gaps in health education, sexual health education, and health resources in our schools and communities so that we can make lasting cultural change for the future that will benefit all of DPS.
